My research follows two interlinked directions: international political theory and policy issues of international peace and security. I am writing on the international political theory of Realism and the English School as well as religion and agency in international politics. Asking what a classical approach (i.e. IR as practical philosophy) can contribute to understanding international politics, my research interrogates the philosophical and anthropological roots of international theory and violence, the agency of individuals and international organizations, and issues for international institutions such as diplomacy and war. My interdisciplinary work also focuses on topics of foreign policy, international cooperation, and international organizations.
